Our dress expectations:

- Students may wear a hat, and we encourage one for sun protection during outdoor time.
- Outerwear like coats should be removed indoors.
- Students should dress for outdoor learning and recess regardless of weather, since Spruce classes go outside year-round.

We do not police fashion or style. We only intervene when clothing presents a disruption to learning, a safety issue, or a violation of school values.
